Through your self-evaluation and our discussions it is evident that there are numerous SMSC related strengths at Endeavour; the following are a few key examples:

- The way that SMSC is a creative thread that runs throughout everything the school does from assemblies to PSHE sessions to interventions and trips and therapy dogs in school.
- The school responds to every child's individual needs and this gives a strong wraparound pastoral support system that extends to home and each student's next life steps.

 The creation of a separate PSHE and careers room and a dedicated teacher gives pupils the opportunity to explore topics in greater depth and develop key life skills.

Areas for development:

- To continue to grow the parent coffee mornings to include face to face as well as virtual meetings.
- To continue to develop the PSHE offer now the room is up and running.
- To ensure the local community and beyond are aware of the good work that Endeavour does by ensuring a presence in local media where possible.
